Their performance continues Malaysia's growing legacy at iGeo and highlights the strength of our young talents on the global stage.

- The Person-in-charge is responsible for enforcing the standard regulations of the competition
- The results will be announced in November 2025
- The e-certificate will be provided in the Contesthub
